European Union Visitors Program (EUVP) 2017

Descrição

The <u>European Union Visitors Program (EUVP)</u> is an individual visitors' program that was established by the European Parliament and the European Commission in 1974. The EUVP invites young, promising leaders from countries outside the European Union to visit Europe to gain a first-hand appreciation of the EU's institutions, policies, values, and people to increase mutual understanding between professionals from non-EU countries and their EU counterparts.

Data Limite

March 1, 2017.

Elegibilidade

Americans with a career-related interest in the European Union are invited to apply for the EUVP.

Eligible participants include government officials (local, state, and federal), journalists, trade unionists, educators, officials of non-profit and non-governmental organizations, and other professionals aged thirty-fourty with career-related interests in the European Union.

Note: Participants are required to have completed their university education or equivalent training and to have been employed for several years in their chosen career field.



Beneficios

An individual five- to eight-day program of meetings with EU officials at the EU institutions in Brussels and/or Strasbourg. All programs are coordinated and arranged by the EUVP Secretariat rather than by individual participants.

Note: Travel and per diem costs are covered by the EUVP.

The scheme aims to support research that will improve public health and tropical medicine at a local, national and global level.

Elegibilidade

Applicants must:

- 1. Be a national of a Low- or Middle-Income Country;
- 2. Hold a clinical or non-clinical undergraduate degree in a subject relevant to public health or tropical medicine;
- 3. Be at an early stage in their career with limited research experience (but they must have a demonstrated interest in, or aptitude for, research);
- 4. Have sponsorship from an <u>Eligible Host Organisation</u> in a low- or middle-income country;
- 5. Have a research proposal that is within Wellcome Trust's <u>Public Health and Tropical Medicine Remit</u>.

Studentship stipend, fees and research expenses.

Centre for International Co-operation in Science (CICS) JNCASR-CICS Fellowship Programme for Scientists from Developing Countries 2016

Descrição

Centre for International Co-operation in Science (CICS) is functioning under the patronage of Dr.Krishan Lal, FNA, President, Indian National Science Academy (INSA), New Delhi and Dr. T. Ramasami, FNA, Secretary, Department of Science



and Technology (DST). The Centre is mandated to spread the spirit of Science and Technology co-operation among developing societies.

The <u>JNCASR-CICS</u> <u>Fellowship</u> <u>Programme</u> <u>for</u> <u>Scientists</u> <u>from</u> <u>Developing</u> <u>Countries</u> is jointly instituted by the Jawaharlal Nehru Centre for Advanced Scientific Research (JNCASR), Bangalore, and CICS, Chennai, to encourage mobility of scientists from developing countries. The Fellowship covers short-term research, training or participatory research work in physical, chemical or biological sciences in reputed scientific institutions in India including JNCASR.

Elegibilidade

Applicant, other than Indian, possessing Doctorate or Master's Degree in Science or equivalent degree in Engineering/ Medicine and allied disciplines, below 45 years of age affiliated to a scientific or academic institution in a developing country, other than India.

Applicant must be a scientist, teacher or a research scholar affiliated to a scientific or academic institution in a developing country in Asia (other than India), Africa, Latin America and Arab region.

Beneficios

The Fellowship covers:

- 1. International return air fare by the shortest route by economy class from the place of work of the candidate at his/her country to the host institution in India:
- 2. Boarding, lodging, for the individual only, at the affiliated institution and other subsistence expenses in the form of an adequate allowance in Indian currency.

Thiel Foundation Fellowships

Descrição

The Thiel Foundation defends and promotes freedom in all its dimensions: political, personal, and economic. The Foundation the Fellows will pursue innovative scientific and technical projects, learn entrepreneurship, and begin to build the technology companies of tomorrow. The project areas for this class of fellows include biotech, career development, economics and finance, education, energy, information technology, mobility, robotics, and space.

Founded by technology entrepreneur and investor Peter Thiel in 2011, the <u>Thiel Foundation Fellowships</u> is a two-year program for young people who want to build new things. Thiel Fellows skip or stop out of college to receive a US\$100,000.00 grant and support from the Thiel Foundation's network of founders, investors, and scientists.

Note: It will be selected between twenty and thirty Fellows each year.

Data Limite

Applications are accepted on a rolling basis and reviewed as they come in.

Elegibilidade

Anyone under the age of 23 years old.

It is accepted applications from around the world.



Note: Fellows are encouraged to spend time during the program in Silicon Valley to make the most of the program.

Beneficios

US\$100,000.00.

Note: The funds can be used however Thiel Fellows want. The Fellowship does not take any ownership stake in the project.

Restrições

Thiel Fellows may not be in school during the two-year Fellowship Program.

Projects with IP restrictions (due to University contracts or cofounder conflicts) are not encouraged.

Appplicants must complete the Application Form.

Observações

Five years since the first Fellowship class, Thiel Fellows have started more than 60 companies that are together worth over US\$1.1 billion, and have created hundreds of jobs in the course of tackling problems ranging from telemedicine and human longevity to solar energy and clean water.

Allen Foundation - Grants 2017

Descrição

The Allen Foundation, established in 1975 by agricultural chemist William Webster Alle, operates under the laws of the State of Michigan with offices in Midland. The policies and priorities of the Allen Foundation are: to make grants to fund relevant nutritional research; and to support programs for the education and training of mothers during pregnancy and after the birth of their children, so that good nutritional habits can be formed at an early age.

The <u>Allen Foundation Grants</u> are strictly limited under the terms of the charter to projects that benefit programs for human nutrition in the areas of health, education, training, and research. Preference may be given to proposals that include matching funds from the institution or other partners including in-kind contribution.

Data Limite

December 31, each year.

Elegibilidade

- 1. Applicants must be a non-profit organization and be able to provide with a copy of their Internal Revenue Service certification of 501(c) 3 tax-exempt status;
- 2. If applying from outside the United States, applicants must inform how the Foundation can document or confirm that they have their country's counterpart or equivalent of the 501(c)(3) form;
- 3. Academic research should be conducted under the leadership of a principal investigator who is a full-time regular faculty member with tenure or on tenure track.

Note: Applicants must access the <u>Eligibility Requirements</u> for additional information.

Valor Financiado

- 1. The grants for <u>Proposals Funded in 2016</u> ranged from US\$2,000.00 to US\$250,000.00.
- 2. Third party contribution to matching funds such as computer or software donated from a company may be included.



Note: The Allen Foundation Inc. imposes a cap of twenty percent (20%) for overhead costs collected (on top of direct costs of completing the project) by colleges and universities.

Restrições

The foundation does not under any circumstances sponsor professional conferences, seminar tables, discussion panels, or similar events.

The foundation does not directly administer the programs which it funds.

Forma de Solicitação

Applicants must take the <u>Eligibility Quiz</u> to discover if their organization is eligible to receive a Grant.

Awesome Foundation - Call for Proposals 2016

Descrição

A Awesome Foundation, ou Fundação Irada, é uma comunidade global dedicada a disseminar projetos irados pelo universo. Por meio da <u>Call for Proposals</u>, cada capítulo é 100% autônomo para apoiar projetos irados através de pequenos prêmios ou doações, geralmente escolhidos uma vez por mês ou bimestralmente. A pequena doação é coletada a partir de doações individuais (pessoa física) dos



"curadores" e é entregue sem pedir qualquer contrapartida às pessoas ou grupos desenvolvendo os projetos irados.

Nota: Cada capítulo fornece os seus próprios prêmios ou doações. Normalmente, dez "curadores" contribuem individualmente com US\$100.00 (ou o equivalente em moeda local) para um prêmio mensal (às vezes bimestral), embora alguns capítulos possuam mais curadores rateando o custo do prêmio.

Data Limite

As propostas são avaliadas continuamente.

Elegibilidade

Qualquer pessoa pode receber um prêmio ou doação: indivíduos, grupos e organizações.

Beneficios

US\$1,000.00.

Restrições

Geralmente, não recebem apoio projetos que tragam apenas beneficios pessoais ou que tenham um impacto pequeno sobre uma comunidade ou até mesmo esforços existentes para os quais uma pequena doação não faria uma diferença significativa.

Forma de Solicitação

Os interessados devem preencher o Formulário de Inscrição.

Nota: Os interessados devem tentar candidatarem-se a um <u>Capítulo</u> próximo. Se isso não for possível, os interessados pode selecionar "Qualquer" no campo "Capítulo" no formulário, ou candidatar-se a um ou mais capítulos temáticos.

Observações

A maioria dos capítulos se reúne mensalmente para avaliar os pedidos e decidir o projeto escolhido, embora alguns capítulos decidam em eventos com apresentação ao vivo "pitch" aberto ao público. Se o candidato ainda não obteve retorno após alguns meses, é provável que o seu projeto não tenha sido selecionado.

A maioria dos capítulos continua considerando os pedidos de meses anteriores, porém não há necessidade de enviar o projeto de novo a menos que a proposta tenha mudado.
