They are not over 35 years of age at the start of the 2017/2018 academic year and have never studied at an education institution in the Netherlands.

MSA - Grant for Student Research in Mineralogy and Petrology 2018

Descrição

The Mineralogical Society of America (MSA) was founded in 1919 for the advancement of mineralogy, crystallography, geochemistry, petrology, and promotion of their uses in other sciences, industry, and the arts. It encourages fundamental research about natural materials and supports the teaching of mineralogical concepts and procedures.

The <u>Grant for Student Research in Mineralogy and Petrology</u> is awarded for research in mineralogy and petrology. Students, including graduate and undergraduate students, are encouraged to apply. However, all proposals are considered together. The Award selection will be based on the qualifications of the applicant, the quality, innovativeness, and scientific significance of the research, and the likelihood of success of the project.

Data Limite

March 1, 2018.

Elegibilidade

Applicants should:

- 1. Be more than one year from completing their degrees;
- 2. Have not obtained a Ph.D. (or equivalent);
- 3. May not apply for both this and the <u>Grant for Research in Crystallography</u> in the same year.

Valor Financiado

Two Awards of up to US\$5,000.00 each.

Note: The Grant is for research-related expenses only.
