AvH - German Chancellor Fellowship for Tomorrow's Leaders 2017

Descrição

The Alexander von Humboldt Foundation (AvH) promotes academic cooperation between excellent scientists and scholars from abroad and from Germany.

The [German Chancellor Fellowship for Tomorrow's Leaders](#) is targeted at university graduates from the United States, the Russian Federation, the People's Republic of China, Brazil and India who have an international outlook and initial leadership experience. It addresses prospective decision-makers, multipliers and thought leaders from a broad range of professional fields such as politics, public administration and business as well as society and culture. The fellowships give them the opportunity to spend a year in Germany networking with other prospective leaders from abroad, who are also sponsored by the Humboldt Foundation, and to explore new solutions to the global issues.

Note: The AvH grants up to fifty fellowships every year - up to ten of which go to prospective leaders from each of the five countries.

Elegibilidade

The applicant must:

1. Be a national of the United States, the Russian Federation, The People's Republic of China, Brazil or India;
2. Have a Bachelor's or equivalent academic degree completed less than twelve years before the beginning of the fellowship (October 1 of the year following application);
3. Work in a sector such as politics, economics, the media, administration and culture;
4. Have German or English language skills and initial proven leadership experience.

The fellowship grant amounts to €2,150.00, €2,450.00 or €2,750.00 per month, depending on the applicant's qualifications. The fellowship also includes a mobility allowance as well as a contribution to health and liability insurance.

Additional benefits:

1. Allowance for research costs amounting to €500.00 per month for the hosts in Germany;
2. Lump sum for the fellow's travel to and from Germany if these costs are not borne by a third party;

3. Allowances for family members accompanying the fellow to Germany for a minimum of three months (up to €326.00 a month for marital partners and up to €234.00 a month for each child);
4. German courses in the fellow's own country prior to the stay in Germany as well as during the stay in Germany to intensify the knowledge of German acquired during the intensive language course;
5. Europe allowance for a stay of one to two months at an institute in Europe (not, however, in the fellow's own country) if such a stay is necessary to conduct the project in question;
6. Extensive alumni sponsorship after the stay in Germany has been completed successfully, in particular, to promote networking with the collaborative partners in Germany during the alumni's entire professional careers.
