FAO - Technical Cooperation Programme

Descrição

The <u>Technical Cooperation Programme (TCP)</u> was launched in 1976 and is a part of FAO's Regular Programme, financed from the assessed contributions of its Members. The TCP is one of FAO's tools for contributing to the achievement of the UN Millennium Development Goals and particularly the goal of eradicating extreme poverty and hunger.

The Programme aims to provide FAO's technical expertise to its Member countries through targeted, short term, catalytic projects. The projects address technical problems in the field of agriculture, fisheries, forestry and rural livelihood that prevent Member countries, either individually or collectively, from implementing their development programmes.

Valor Financiado

The maximum budget is US\$500,000.00.

Forma de Solicitação

Requests for TCP assistance should be addressed to the Director-General of FAO.

There is no rigid format for the presentation of requests for TCP assistance. However, to ensure prompt action and to avoid the need to return to the originator for clarification, requests should be accompanied by a project draft or outline or otherwise contain, in sufficient detail, the basic information required for appraising and preparing a draft project agreement.

The standard format of TCP project agreements as well as the relevant instructions for their preparation is provided in annex 2 of the TCP Guidelines for National Stakeholders.

NIH - Diet and Physical Activity Assessment Methodology (R01)

Descrição

The National Institutes of Health (NIH), a part of the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, is the primary Federal agency for conducting and supporting medical research. Composed of <u>27 Institutes and Centers</u>, the NIH provides leadership and financial support to researchers in every state and throughout the world.

This Funding Opportunity Announcement (FOA) encourages innovative research to enhance the quality of measurements of dietary intake and physical activity. Applications submitted under this FOA are encouraged to include development of: novel assessment approaches; better methods to evaluate instruments; assessment tools for culturally diverse populations or various age groups, including children and older adults; improved technology or applications of existing technology; statistical methods/modeling to improve assessment and/or to correct for measurement errors or biases; methods to investigate the multidimensionality of diet and physical activity behavior through pattern analysis; or integrated measurement of diet and physical activity along with the environmental context of such behaviors.

Elegibilidade

Non-domestic (non-U.S.) Entities (Foreign Institutions) are eligible to apply. Foreign (non-US) institutions must follow policies described in the <u>NIH Grants Policy Statement</u>, and procedures for foreign institutions described throughout the Application Guide.

Any individual(s) with the skills, knowledge, and resources necessary to carry out the proposed research as the Program Director/Principal Investigator (PD/PI) is invited to work with his/her



organization to develop an application for support. Individuals from underrepresented racial and ethnic groups as well as individuals with disabilities are always encouraged to apply for NIH support.

Applicants must have a valid <u>Dun and Bradstreet Universal Numbering System (DUNS)</u> number in order to begin each of the following registrations: <u>Central Contractor Registration (CCR)</u>, <u>Grants.gov</u> and <u>eRA Commons</u>.

Valor Financiado

Application budgets are not limited but need to reflect the actual needs of the proposed project. The total project period may not exceed five years.

Forma de Solicitação

Applicants must download the SF424 (R&R) application package associated with this funding opportunity using the <u>Apply for Grant Electronically</u> or following the directions provided at <u>Grants.gov</u>.

It is critical that applicants follow the instructions in the <u>SF424 (R&R) Application Guide</u>, including <u>Supplemental Grant Application Instructions</u> except where instructed in this funding opportunity announcement to do otherwise.
